The tests are planned at three different levels of preparation required for a student to succeed in CSE -Prelims.

1. Basic level

Initially, the tests will be completely based on Fundamentals. Every subject - History, Geography, Polity, Indian Economy, Science and technology -- will have 2 such tests each. Environment will have 1 Basic Level Test. Here we will test whether you have thoroughly prepared from the fundamental sources or not, especially from the NCERTs and standard books.

2. Advanced level

In the next level, for all the subjects mentioned above, there will be a test each. These are designed to make the student put in a good deal of thought and will test his abilities of understanding the subjects holistically and analytically. It is to say that, we will test your subject knowledge at an applied level. The application oriented questions, apart from being analytical, will strongly draw some elements from Current Affairs. As a result, these tests would not be restricted to few particular sources. These tests can be seen as the ones that fill the knowledge gaps.

3. Current Affairs Tests

These tests will contain nothing but Current Affairs related questions. The Questions are framed on the lines of UPSC pattern and the sources for Current Affairs will be only the Standard Sources. Picking up questions from sources which are not within the reach of a student and questions which would never appear in the UPSC prelims paper will be outrightly rejected. Legacy IAS Monthly Current Affairs, which covers The Hindu, Indian Express, PIB and RSTV in entirety, would be the primary source for these Tests.

After 11 of these tests, the last 2 to 3 months Current Affairs will be merged with FLTs itself

4. Full length Tests (FLTs)

These are comprehensive tests. There are 10 in number, all of which try to measure up to the standard of UPSC Question papers. Taking these tests and thorough revision of answer keys will lend credence to your preparation, make you self-confident, thus validating that your preparation is complete.

5. CSAT Tests

Given that the score required in Paper 2 is only 67, yet candidates have faltered in this paper despite scoring well in Paper 1, we have increased the number of tests considering the increasing level of difficulty in the paper. These tests will be interspersed with the GS tests. Practice with enough spacing between tests would yield best results.

Defining Features

1. Comprehensively covers syllabus in entirety, as delineated by UPSC.
2. The standard set for questions (MCQs) is at par with that of UPSC prelims.
3. Subject based Sectional Tests help students to evaluate one's own performance, ensuring them that their preparation is tested and instils a sense of confidence
4. The design of question papers has been made to adhere to the UPSC pattern, thus the nature of questions would bring to the fore the factual, analytical and conceptual aspects.
5. Sufficient Current Affairs integration will be done even as the MCQs take shape, which makes justice to the dynamic nature of pattern
6. Options of MCQs are articulated upon thorough research of previous year's UPSC Prelims papers and have been arranged in such a manner that the elimination tactics can be applied by students while solving questions.
7. All tests will be conducted in same manner as in real examination hall which helps in better time management and prepare students to solve MCQs correctly under exam pressure.
8. Performance Analysis of aspirants in a particular test will be done, and necessary course corrections in preparation strategies will be suggested
